Writing Guidelines

These guidelines are a reminder to give credit where credit is due, along with some submission instructions. By submitting your article to MHM, you give us permission to publish the article on the "Media" page of MineralHouseMedia.com, to share the story on Instagram, and to share the story to Facebook. If at any time you wish to modify or remove the article, just send us an email and we will make whatever changes you need. As de facto editors, we may need to make minor modifications or suggestions once your article is submitted. We will run these changes by you if they are more significant than simple grammatical fixes.

How to Submit:

We don't have deadlines, but we do have specific publication dates:

- All of November 2019
- All of December 2019
- 1. Send text via Google Docs or in the body of an email. Don't stress over formatting because all of that will be reworked when we add the text to our website.
- 2. Send all images with notes via email, Dropbox, or Google Drive
- 3. Don't forget your bio!
- 4. We edit, format, and share.
- 5. You share!

Content:

We are looking for written content that analyzes contemporary art in any of the following ways:

- Show review
- Show analysis
- Written Interview with an artist
- Analysis of current trend with reference to contemporary artists
- Gallery review / Interview with a gallery owner
- We are happy to hear any other ideas!

Length:

As stated above, our main objective is that the act of writing benefits the writer. Thus, we will accept any length of writing, from a 2-paragraph review to a 10-page analysis.

Photos:

The article benefits from good-quality photos of the work. If you do not take the photos yourself, make sure you have express permission from the artist or gallery who provides the images. Be sure to include the following information with each image:

- Artist
- Title
- Materials (if available)
- Year (if available)
- Image credit
- A note about where the image should be inserted into the article

Exhibition Information:

Be sure to include the following information in your show review or analysis:

- Gallery Name
- City/Gallery location
- Curator of the show (if a group exhibition)
- Dates of the Exhibition
- Contact information for the artist (website, email, or Instagram, etc.)

About the Writer:

With your article, we will publish a short bio and a photo of you. If you are an artist, we are happy to shout out your practice as well. This can give readers some insight into your unique analytical lens. Please send this information with the article.
